## "The Transat Holidays Early Booking Event" CONTEST

## CONTEST RULES (the "Rules")

The "The Transat Holidays Early Booking Event" contest (the "Contest") is organized by Transat Tours Canada Inc. operating under the name Transat Holidays (the "Organizer"). The Contest begins on October 11, 2013 at 00:01, Montreal time (the "Contest Opening Date"), and ends on October 31, 2013, at 23:59, Montreal time (the "Contest Closing Date").

## 1. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to all residents of Canada who have reached the age of majority in their province or territory of residence by the Contest Opening Date, except for employees, agents, mandataries and representatives of the Organizer, their subsidiaries, affiliates, affiliated companies, advertising or promotion agencies, the suppliers of material, prizes and services related to this Contest, and any other stakeholder directly related to the holding of the Contest, as well as the members of their immediate family (father, mother, brothers, sisters, children and legal or de facto spouse) and anyone with whom these employees, representatives and agents reside.

## 2. HOW TO ENTER

#### 2.1 Purchase necessary

To be entered automatically into the Contest, the contestant (the "Contestant") must purchase, between October 11 and 31, 2013, a Transat Holidays Distinction or Luxury Collections vacation packages of 6 nights or more. The traveling must be done between December 19, 2013 and April 30, 2014. However, the Participant having reserved a Transat Holiday Distinction or Luxury Collection vacation package within the aforementioned delays will have the option to modify the date of travel when applicable on one occasion, in which case, travel must be completed by October 31, 2014.

#### 2.2 No purchase necessary

To enter the Contest by mail, without purchase, print your full name, home address, home telephone number, age and a 50-word text describing the reasons why you would like to win the Contest. Mailed entries must be received before the Contest Closing date. Only one entry per person per home address.

## 3. PRIZE

One (1) prize (hereinafter the **Prize**) shall be awarded.

3.1 The **Prize** consists of winning five (5) South all inclusive Transat Tours Canada Inc. packages. The Contest winner will receive five (5) all inclusive South packages worth a maximum value of four thousand dollars CDN (\$4,000) each for a total value of twenty thousand dollars CDN (\$20,000).

# 4. CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE PRIZES

- 4.1 Bookings are subject to the availability of the Organizer at the time of reservation. The Terms and Conditions of Transat Holidays' current South Collection brochure apply. Taxes, airport fees, customs duties, entry fees and tourist cards, surcharges, insurance charges, personal expenses, personal travel insurance and travel documents are not included in the Prize. The Contest Organizers strongly recommend that the selected Contestant and his/her travelling companion purchase travel insurance.
- 4.2 The selected Contestant and his/her travelling companion must travel together both ways. Travel arrangements will be made by the Organizer. The Contestant and his/her travelling companion are responsible for their own transportation upon departure and arrival at the international airport of departure, as determined by the Organizer. The travelling companion of the selected Contestant shall be Canadian residents who have reached the age of majority in their province by the Contest Opening Date. In the event that the Prize is not accepted in accordance with the conditions attached thereto, the Prize shall be deemed forfeited or non-available.
- 4.5 Reservations and arrangements for the Prize related to reservation of the All inclusive packages must be made by the Organizer, on the date agreed upon by the selected Contestant at least thirty (30) days before departure and will be subject to availability. ## 5. DRAW

One (1) random draw will be made on November 11, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. The draws will take place at the Transat Holidays office at 300 Léo Pariseau, Suite 1000, Montreal (Quebec) H2X 4C2.

#### 6. PRIZE CLAIM

6.1 In order to be declared a winner, the selected Contestant must:

- 6.1.1 Be reached by email or by telephone by the Contest Organizer within forty-eight (48) hours of the draw and correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question. If the selected entrant cannot be reached by telephone within forty-eight (48) hours from the initial call, all of his or her rights to the Prize shall be forfeited and an alternative entry will be randomly drawn. If the second participant cannot be contacted by telephone or email within forty-eight (48) hours from the initial call, all of his or her rights to the Prize shall be forfeited and an alternative entry will be randomly drawn. - 6.3 In default of observing any of the conditions mentioned above or any other conditions stipulated in these Rules, the selected Contestant will be disqualified and the Prize that would have been awarded will be forfeited. Upon receipt of the duly completed and signed Declaration Form, the Contest Organizers will contact the winners in order to inform them on how to take possession of their prize.
