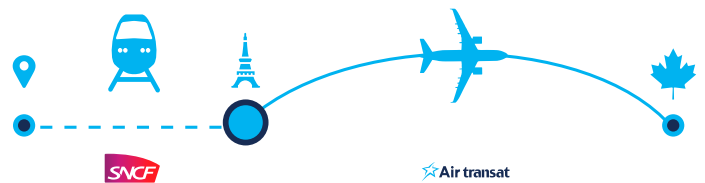
Air Transat now offers its customers a combined air and train service that is **completely digitalized**, in partnership with the SNCF in France.

Steps of the trip towards Canada



- 

Your customer downloads his e-ticket available 72 hours before the train departure from the website check-in.accesrail.com.
The ticket is also the day of the train's departure, on self-service terminals in stations.

Your customer arrives at the TGV station (TN) at terminal 2 at Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport.

They then proceed to terminal 3 of the airport.

They check in at the Air Transat counter to collect their boarding pass and drop off their luggage.
Check-in for Air Transat flights is also available 24 hours before departure, online, on the [website](#) or the application.

Advantages of the TGV AIR

Peace of mind: In case of a flight or train delay, seats are automatically confirmed on the next available flight or train (as the case may be).

Easy travel: It's one booking, one rate for air and railway travel combined. All changes to an itinerary can be processed in the same request.
